

Programs Available

Infant

6 weeks to 12 months

1:3 teacher-to-child ratio

In this nurturing and supportive program, infants begin to develop warm, positive relationships by interacting with adults, as well as their peers. This instills a sense of competence, along with trust for the world around them.

The idea is to use a range of multi-sensory activities to promote fine & gross motor skills, language acquisition, socio-emotional development, and cognitive abilities.

Yearling & Young Toddler

12 to 24 months

1:6 teacher-to-child ratio

In this exciting and active space, children continue to develop their motor, communication and cognitive skills. This new knowledge is tested through interaction with peers; climbing, building, moving things, while using various forms of artistic expression. Children are introduced to a vast array of experiences to enhance their early literacy skills. Through careful observation, our teachers facilitate meaningful activities to foster each child's development.

Toddler Two

2 to 3 years

1:6 teacher-child ratio

This is a special place for children who are still toddlers, but ready for a fresh new set of challenges before entering preschool. Teachers extend the learning process by introducing more stimuli, providing the opportunity to refine existing skills while acquiring many more. The focus on literacy experiences is also increased in this program.

Preschool

3 and 4 years

1:9 teacher-to-child ratio

In the Learning Brooke preschool, projects take on a life of their own — lasting days or months depending on the children's interest. Since teachers are concerned with the entire process — rather than the products of a particular event — our teachers allow as much time as necessary for a project's successful completion.

Children participate in large groups, small groups and individual experiences. Routines are followed to help the children keep themselves, and others, healthy and safe. Here the children will find

Note: All children in the preschool program must be toilet-trained.

Pre-K & Kindergarten

5 to 6 years

1:10 teacher-to-child ratio

Our full-day Kindergarten offers a learning-rich program that is both safe and developmentally appropriate. Teachers collaborate to bring the “emergent” curriculum to life — based on the current and changing interests of the children. Each project entails integration of language arts, mathematics, science, social studies and visual arts.

At this stage of development, children are constructing a body of knowledge — and a desire for learning — that will last a lifetime. Appropriately, our teachers make a special effort to support and nurture their diverse needs and creative investigations.

Each kindergarten student receives a biannual narrative report card, which is presented at a personal parent/teacher conference. A description of the program’s Curriculum, Goals and Objectives will be shared with individual families by request.
